The Renaissance (RCLF) factory located in Roanoke, VA. U.S.A., is pleased to share this reference list showing procedures and materials that are sensitive to the environment as well as the requests made within the architectural and specification community

- **“Powder Coating”** – This extremely environmentally friendly process is utilized on all of our products from lamps to metal furniture. With no harmful emissions or fumes this technique is safe for the environment and offers great adhesion and durability to all types of products
- **“Recycled Metal”** – All of our metal products are created from “Recycled Steel” materials. Any waste from metal fabricating is stored and returned to the distributor to be melted down and recycled into usable products for other industries
- **“Shot Blasting”** – The metal version of sandblasting, our shot blast facility is an 18’ x 12’ self-contained reclaiming enclosure that provides optimal cleaning of metal components and provides an etched surface for excellent adhesion of decorative finishes.
- **“Faux Finishing”** – As is common in our industry, many products require a touch of hand applied finishing or distressing to create just the right look. Renaissance is pleased to accomplish our through a series of **“Water Base Solvents”** that create these unique features.
- **“Cardboard Recycling Program & Packaging”** – Renaissance utilizes a combination of recycled corrugated materials and clean unused newsprint to package our products. All waste cardboard is offered to local recyclers
- **“Re-Manufactured Shipping Pallets”** – A great way to save trees and preserve the environment!
- **Employee Supported Recycling Program**

As you are aware Renaissance recycles our scrap metal and cardboard into specific dumpsters. Recycling has become very important nationwide and companies are being looked upon to help support employee sponsored programs.
